


# The <sup>1204-2004</sup> Rowell 000 charter

Wherefore, we will and firmly declare the aforesaid market and fair of us and our heirs in perpetuity well and in peace freely, quietly, fully and with honour with all the free customs belonging.

This is your invitation to a unique historic event as bestowed upon the people of Rothwell by King John in 1204. The ceremony has been continuously proclaimed since that time to the present day.


